1. God's Presence in Unfamiliar Seasons

Psalms 139:9-10 — “If I rise on the wings of the dawn, if I settle on the far side of the sea, even there your hand will guide me, your right hand will hold me fast.”

Isaiah 43:2 — “When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and when you pass through the rivers, they will not sweep over you.”

Deuteronomy 31:6 — “Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid or terrified because of them, for the Lord your God goes with you; he will never leave you nor forsake you.”

2. Guidance and Direction

Psalms 119:105 — “Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light for my path.”

Philippians 4:6-7 — “Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.”

Psalms 46:1-2 — “God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble. Therefore we will not fear, though the earth give way...”

4. God's Faithfulness and Guidance

Lamentations 3:22-23 — “Because of the Lord's great love we are not consumed, for his compassions never fail. They are new every morning; great is your faithfulness.”

Romans 8:28 — “And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose.”

Psalms 32:8 — “I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will counsel you with my loving eye on you.”

5. Hope and Assurance for the Future
